

Bishop Curtis Scholarship Process 2022

The Bishop Curtis Scholarship Fund was established to support families-in-need in sending their children to summer camp. Any family affiliated with an Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Olympia is eligible for financial assistance, regardless of their circumstance.

Typically: the camper's family, the camper's church, and the Bishop Curtis Scholarship Fund each cover 1/3 of the cost of the camp session. Here is the step-by-step process:

1. Clergy members (or Senior Warden if a congregation is in search) request funds from The Office of the Bishop. Submit scholarship application forms at <https://resources.ecww.org/bishop-curtis-scholarship-requests> or contact **Tonja Mathews** at **tmathews@ecww.org** to request a form. You can request up to 10 camper scholarships per online submission form.
2. Tell the family to register for camp online at www.huston.org or use the enclosed brochures. When registering, families should check the box regarding scholarships to inform us of their payment plan.
3. Please inform the camper's family after receiving confirmation from the Bishop's Office. Once the Bishop's Office confirms the scholarship amount with Camp Huston, we will apply it to the camper's registration.
4. The Church office is responsible for sending Camp Huston 1/3 of the cost of the camper's registration (or other amount agreed upon between the church and family). Please include the camper's name and the session they are registered to attend. If the church is sending payment for more than one camper, please identify how much money is allotted for each camper by name and session.
